- (1) Scores for publications/works created through the collaboration of more than one researcher are multiplied by 0.8 for two collaborators; by 0.6 for three collaborators and by 0.4 for four or more collaborators. Undergraduate, post-graduate or doctoral researchers, with whom the instructor works together, are not taken into account in the calculation.
- (2) The Impact Factor for Web of Science and CiteScore for SCOPUS should be over 1. This score is 0.6 and over regarding legal publications. For publications indexed in both the Web of Science and SCOPUS, CiteScore calculated by SCOPUS is the basis. Since the impact factor of the AHCI index in Web of Science is not calculated, the SCOPUS CiteScore value, if any, is taken as the basis for the journals in this index. Publications in international refereed journals without a CiteScore or an impact factor are evaluated within the framework of APPENDIX-1 Article 1.2
- (3) The Academic Board is authorized to decide on which publishers, journals, galleries, theaters, art institutions etc. shall be evaluated in the in “renowned” category. National Publishers which are evaluated within the “Renowned” Category by University Executive Board are listed in APPENDIX-2, the International Publishers are listed in APPENDIX-3, renowned art institutions are listed in APPENDIX-4, Journals to be evaluated within the

“Renowned” Category by Faculty of Law are listed in APPENDIX-5. Regarding the list of international publishers; publishers which are recommended by departments are taken into consideration as well as the publishers indexed in SCOPUS.

- (4) The works produced in the fields of art and design are evaluated only 1 (one) time, although multiple copies are produced and exhibited in different places.
- (5) For hiring, number of references in the last three years for a publication made in journals included in SCOPUS or Web of Science series; In title promotions, number of references in the last three years for each publication with KPAS address in journals included in SCOPUS or Web of Science reference series; For contract renewals, the number of references in the last contract period for each publication with KHAS address in journals included in SCOPUS or Web of Science reference series shall be taken into consideration. For the Law School, the scientific peer-reviewed journals scanned in the national database of TÜBİTAK-ULAKBİM, journals listed in the “Recognized” Category for the Faculty of Law (ANNEX-5) and references made in the decisions of higher judicial bodies shall be accepted.
- (6) For this field, the number of different courses given by the instructor shall be requested. For the upgrades within the university, only the different courses organized at Kadir Has University shall be evaluated.
- (7) Only the projects supported by resources outside the university and classified under the research project category by the R&D Resources Directorate shall be taken into consideration.
- (8) Scientific events that last 3 or more days, with a large number of parallel sessions, are considered a “Convention”.
