

**KADİS HAS UNIVERSITY**  
**REGULATION ON SUPPORTING THE SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS WHO ARE**  
**BENEFITING FROM MONEY FUNDS OTHER THAN THE UNIVERSITY BUDGET**

**Purpose and Scope**

**Article 1-** The purpose of this Regulation is to determine the additional financial support to be given by Kadir Has University (KHAS) to the bachelor's degree, master's degree and PhD students as well as the postdoctoral researchers received scholarships by the KHAS academics through external money funds they receive from outside the university, and the principles to be applied the foregoing.

**Definitions**

**Article 2-** The following terms mentioned in this regulation shall mean as designated below:

- a) Scholarship Holder: Kadir Has University bachelor's degree, master's degree and PhD students as well as the postdoctoral researchers working in the academics' projects, all of whom are provided scholarships by the KHAS academics through the external money funds they receive from outside the university.
- b) Financial Affairs Head of Department: Kadir Has University Financial Affairs Head of Department.
- c) Board of Overseers: Kadir Has University Board of Overseers.
- d) Project: The projects which are coordinated by KHAS academics and which cause the provision of money funds from outside the university.
- e) Project coordinator: KHAS academics who coordinate the project which causes the provision of money funds from outside the university.
- f) Rector: The Rector of Kadir Has University.
- g) Rectorate: Kadir Has University Rectorate.
- h) University: Kadir Has University.

**Determining the Scholarship Holder**

**Article 3 –** The scholarship holders who become entitled to benefit from the scholarship in the scope of this Regulation herein are reported in writing by the Project coordinator academic to the Research and Development (R&D) Resources Directorate. The scholarship holder becomes entitled to the financial support as of the month following the date of the foregoing notification. The payment and follow-up of the additional financial support provided to the scholarship holders are carried out by the R&D Resources Directorate.

**The Scholarship Amount**

**Article 4 –** (1) The additional financial resource amounts to be provided by the university to the scholarship holders for the year 2019 are determined as follows:

Bachelor's Degree Student	TL 250
Master's Degree Student	TL 1000
PhD Student	TL 1500
Postdoctoral Researcher	TL 2000

(2) The amount of the scholarship to be provided to the scholarship holders in the following years is determined by the Board of Overseers, provided that such amount shall not be less than 1/3 of the monthly scholarship amount obtained from the money funds received from outside the university.

(3) The scholarship amounts listed above are monthly and net amounts, and are paid to the scholarship holder on the last working day of each month.

**Obligations of the Scholarship Holder**

**Article 5 –** (1) The scholarship holder must be present at the University in line with the University

academics' working days and hours, except the studies/works that he/she will perform for the project outside the university with the project coordinator's approval.

(2) The scholarship holder cannot work full-time or part-time at another workplace either on his/her own account or under any real or legal person.

(3) The scholarship holder must carry out the requirements of the project that he/she participates in and must act in compliance with the project coordinator's directions and instructions.

### **Cease of the Scholarship**

**Article 6** – If the project coordinator identifies that the scholarship holder is/was acting against his/her obligations listed under article 5 herein, then the project coordinator notifies the Rectorate in written of the circumstances. By carrying out the required investigation, the Rectorate might decide on either cease or continuation of the scholarship. According to this:

- a) The provisions of the KHAS Regulation on Associate Degree and Bachelor's Degree Scholarships are reserved for scholarship holders who are registered under bachelor's degree programs.
- b) The provisions of the KHAS Regulation on the Application and Acceptance Conditions to the Postgraduate Programs as well as the Postgraduate Students' Obligations and Postgraduate Scholarships are reserved for scholarship holders who are registered under postgraduate programs.
- c) As for the postdoctoral researchers, if the obligations are not performed, then the Rectorate might cease the scholarship upon recommendation of the Project coordinator.

### **Miscellaneous**

**Article 7** – The provisions of the KHAS Regulation on Postgraduate Education and Training are reserved for scholarship holders who are registered under postgraduate programs; the provisions of the Regulation on the Associate Degree and Bachelor's Degree Scholarships are reserved for scholarship holders who are registered under the bachelor's degree program; and the provisions of Regulation on the Guest Lecturers/Academicians are reserved for postdoctoral researchers.

### **Effect**

**Article 8-** This Regulation enters into effect as of 01.01.2019.

### **Execution**

**Article 9-** The provisions of this Regulation are executed by the Rector of Kadir Has University.
